As an integral part of the Golf Professional Team, the Assistant Golf Professional will:

- Assist and collaborate on the execution of all aspects of the golf operation
- · Assist with merchandising and special-order processing
- Play golf with the membership
- Provide private and group instruction to the membership
- Provide a welcoming environment to members and their guests
- Utilize Golf Genius software for the setup of each event
- Take an active role in the golf shop retail operation, assisting with shop sales, visual merchandising, special ordering, receiving, and invoice processing

- Be familiar with the Rules of Golf
- Maintain a dialogue with the Superintendent and Grounds team while becoming familiar with course-related agronomic practices
- Be informed on Club activities and communicate with fellow staff and the membership on current and future events
- Perform daily opening and closing procedures
- Maintain proficiency with industry technology, including Golf Genius and Club Essential
- Communicate in a professional manner with all Club team members
- Maintain a clean and organized workspace
- Maintain high standard of personal appearance and grooming.
- Be available for a full-time work schedule which will include days, evenings, weekends, and holidays as needed.
- Be prepared to work approximately 40-50 hours per week
